Water Use and Conservation Bylaw No. 505, 2024

VILLAGE OF **radium**
hot springs

To support water conservation and ensure reliable service through the year, the Village of Radium Hot Springs has water use restrictions in place. Restrictions follow a staged system, ranging from Stage 1 (year-round limits) to Stage 5 (severe drought conditions or emergency response), with each stage outlining what is and is not allowed. Be sure to check the current stage and permitted activities before turning on the tap. Current restrictions are online at radiumhotsprings.ca/village-living/watering-restrictions/.
